**No tickets are necessary. The stadium will open at 5:00 p.m. and you can save seats for immediate family only. One person must remain on site in the seated area. Blankets, signs and other markers will be removed if no one is there.**

## **GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS**

Participation in the graduation ceremony is a privilege. In order to walk in commencement ceremonies and receive their diploma, students must meet all graduation requirements.

Regular diploma requirements include 24 full credits of required course work, demonstrated proficiency in the Essential Skill of Reading, Writing, and Math; demonstrated attainment of Career Related Learning knowledge, skills, and experiences; and through individualized planning for a career or college.

Please be aware that many colleges have additional requirements for admission. It is critical that seniors plan their course of instruction carefully to meet diploma requirements. If students or parents have any questions on status, they should contact their counselor.
