

Important Information about Sprague Summer Credit Recovery

As this school year comes to a close, we are reaching out to any students in grades 9-11 who will not earn credit in a core class (NG) this semester.

If you will be earning a NG in any of the following courses, you will be enrolled in summer credit recovery and have an opportunity to earn the credit this summer:

English 9, English 10, and English 11.

Algebra 1, Geometry, and Algebra 2.

20th Century 1 (World Social Science), 20th Century 2, American Government and Economics.

Physical/Chemical Systems and Biological Systems.

Sprague Summer Credit Recovery will continue with distance learning, offered through Edgenuity with no face-to-face classes with teachers. You can earn credit for up to 2 courses; once you complete a class, you will have the opportunity to begin another course. Teachers will be available Monday through Friday from 8:30 -11:30 a.m. to help you.

Classes officially start on Monday, June 15. You will have until July 10 to complete up to 2 classes for credit recovery.

A P (pass) will be issued to students who complete 60% of the class with a grade of 60% and above. A NG will be issued for those below 60% complete and/or are below a grade of 60% on Friday, July 10 (the last day of Summer Credit Recovery).

Students are not able to enroll in classes that they have never attempted nor enroll in a course in which they have received credit and hope to improve their letter grade (such as they received a D and want to improve their grade to a C or above).
