## Who can participate?

- You must be a United States citizen, permanent resident alien, refugee, asylee or parolee, or other person authorized to work in the United States
- You must be between 16 and 24 years old
- You must qualify as low-income
- You must show a need for basic skills development, further education, or training to become employable
- Male applicants ages 18 and older must register with the Selective Service
- You must participate in group activities and follow all of the College's student conduct policies
- Other eligibility rules may apply.
