PREPARING TO COMPLETE THE 2022-2023 FAFSA/ORSAA?

Helpful hints to make the process a little easier



FAFSA/ORSAA ~ FREE APPLICATIONS FOR FEDERAL STUDENT AID



Create an FSA ID
Students that have a social security number must create an FSA ID to electronically sign their FAFSA. Students that **do not have** a social security number will **not** create an FSA ID and will complete the ORSAA (Oregon Student Aid Application), an alternative application for free federal student aid. If you are not sure which application, you should complete go to:

Gather the following documents to assist in completing the FAFSA

STUDENT LIST:

- Mailing address including zip code
- Social security number (enter your name exactly as it appears on your Social Security Card!)
- Driver's license number (if you have one)
- Alien Registration number (if you are not a U.S. citizen)
- **2020** IRS Federal tax returns or W-2 information if didn't file taxes (if you worked in 2020)
- Information on cash, savings and checking account balances

PARENT/GUARDIAN LIST: (person/people considered the student's parent/legal guardian under the FAFSA guidelines)

- Date(s) of Birth
- Social security number (s)
- Driver's license number (if you have one)
- Alien Registration number (if you are not a U.S. citizen)
- Date your parents were married, divorced, or separated
- **2020** Federal tax returns including **2020** IRS W-2 information
- **2020** Records of your untaxed income, such as child support received, interest income, and veterans noneducation benefits
- Information on cash, savings and checking account balances; investments, including stocks and bonds and real estate (but not including the home in which you live); and business and farm assets

Tips on student, school, and parent demographics fields

Student Demographics

Male students must be registered with Selective Service to receive financial aid. You can register directly on the FAFSA by checking "Register me."

School Selection

Select the college, university, or career technology center you plan to attend. You can select up to 10 schools. You will also need to indicate whether you plan to live on campus, off campus or with a parent. FAFSA will send financial information to the colleges on your school selection.

Parent Demographics

Dependent students must enter information about their legal parent(s).
If your parents are legally separated or divorced, list the parent you lived with the most during the last 12 months.
If your parents are legally separated or divorced and you lived with them equally, list the parent who provided the most financial support in the last 12 months.
If your divorced parent is remarried, list both your parent and step-parent.
If your parents are unmarried but living together, list information for both parents.
If your parent is undocumented, use 000-00-0000 as his/her Social Security Number.

Download a copy of your Student Aid Report = SAR, you will need to view this information frequently.
