

# Bond construction update

## Sprague High School

### November 2021

Bond-funded construction improvements will continue this winter at Sprague High School. Voters passed a bond measure in 2018 to fund improvements across the entire district.

Bond funding is providing nearly \$47 million in additions and expansions at Sprague to expand career and technical (vocational) education (CTE) opportunities, prepare for future enrollment growth, increase safety and security, increase support for special education and music and protect the public's investment in the school building.

#### Photo updates and construction progress:

#### Highlights of construction planned at Sprague include:

- 17 new general education classrooms
- Two new science labs
- Three expanded CTE program spaces for fabrication, sports medicine and computer-aided design
- Additional spaces to support special education
- Expanded commons
- Relocated front office for improved security and wayfinding
- New music room, including expanded practice and storage spaces
- Seismic improvements and more

Construction is expected to be substantially complete early in the fall of 2022.
